WORKSHOP DETAILS:

This workshop will be presented over two days and includes both theoretical components as well as reviewing settings, applications and case studies. It has been broken down to:

Day One: The Big Picture – The fit between OT and Behaviour Support

- Why understanding and addressing behaviour is a core OT domain.
- Current models of positive behaviour support, how they fit with OT and the evidence base behind positive behaviour support.
- Assessment and intervention tools and frameworks; supported by clinical examples of how these can be used.
- Specialist OT skills and how they add to behaviour support including sensory processing and occupational engagement and identity.

Day Two: Putting it into Practice – Settings, applications and case studies

- Specialist settings: reflect on additional factors related to settings and client groups including mental health, disability, autism and trauma/ abuse.
- Managing risk: tools for risk assessment, risk minimisation and emergency management plans.
- Suggested frameworks for working in various roles including consultation, education provision, team-based service delivery and sole practitioner.
- Case Studies: work together to apply learning and tools to case studies from participants' clinical practice.

PRESENTER DETAILS:



Kate Horstmann is an occupational therapist currently working at James Cook University as both a lecturer and as a clinician in their pilot children's clinic. Kate has worked with children and adolescents with a range of developmental, neurological and emotional difficulties for more than 10 years. She has gained this experience within a variety of service settings, both in Australia and the United Kingdom, including work as a clinical specialist in the fields of autism, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder and complex behaviour. Kate has undertaken advanced training in a range of fields including sensory processing and applied behaviour analysis/ positive behaviour support. In addition to

working as a direct clinician, team leader and consultant, she has provided training to hundreds of parents, teachers and professionals, and presented at national and international conferences.

Kate has recently co-authored the book *Helping Kids and Teens with ADHD in School: A Workbook for Classroom Support and Managing Transitions*, which is available internationally.
