The Graduate Certificate and Masters in Mental Health Practice are new and innovative programs aiming to capture emerging community needs in multidisciplinary and collaborative professional roles within the mental health workforce to deliver mental health services in a diversity of settings.

The Graduate Certificate and Master of Mental Health Practice at Griffith will be focussed on offering community and recovery based courses through off campus study modes. The program will be targeted at a range of workers in the mental health arena including nursing and allied health professionals as well as other mental health workers such as disability workers, housing officers, police liaison officers and other mental health support roles.
