About RQBCHS:

Royal Queensland Bush Children's Health Scheme provides allied health services to children in regional and rural areas of the state. We currently have teams in 5 communities (Mt Isa, Emerald, Bundaberg, Dalby and Warwick), with each providing regular outreach to surrounding areas.

Each multidisciplinary team comprises a Psychologist, Occupational Therapist, Speech & Language Pathologist, Family Health Support Worker providing parenting and health education programs and administrative support.

Services are delivered in-centre as well as in local schools, special education units, and other community-based settings. All teams are managed by support staff from the Head Office in Brisbane.

Duties:

The Occupational Therapist works closely with other team members providing clinical assessments and therapy programs for children from birth to 13 years. Our clients have a wide range of developmental needs, offering the therapist a diverse and interesting caseload.

The focus of therapy is on using evidence-based interventions to deliver both short-term and long-term outcomes using a comprehensive child-centered case management approach. In addition, preventative community-based health education programs are encouraged.

Support for Staff:

- Competency-based mentoring program for all staff (Level 1 for new graduates and Advanced for experienced practitioners).
- In-house and external professional development program.
- Case management support from senior practitioners using video conference facilities.
- Assistance with relocation expenses.
- Salary Sacrificing available.

Qualifications:

- Four year degree in Occupational Therapy and registration with the Qld Health Practitioners' Board;
 - Experience working with children, small groups and families.
 - Experience working in multidisciplinary teams;
 - Interest in service delivery in remote areas.
- (New graduates would not be expected to comply with the full selection criteria).
