Linda Atkinson *B. Occ Thy* is an occupational therapist who graduated in 1981 and has extensive clinical experience across a broad range of service areas both in Australia and the United Kingdom. She is a current member of the Australian Pain Society. Linda has worked at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital for 20 years, specialising in the area of persistent pain for the last six years.



Michael Deen *B. Occ Thy (Hons) M.Phil* is an occupational therapist. He is currently the Queensland Director of the Australian Pain Society and a member of the steering committee of the National Pain Summit. He has 10 years experience in the management of persistent pain and is currently employed as the Clinical Co-ordinator at the Multidisciplinary Pain Clinic.
