

Computer Aided Design for Home Modifications: Basic training for OTs Paint and Word Drawing Tools

Description

A training session for occupational therapists, in the use of commonly available software, to create diagrams for basic home modification recommendations. It is designed to introduce participants to the techniques and concepts associated with using Microsoft Paint and Word Drawing Tools. Training is provided by '*e-allied health informatics*' and conducted by Melanie Dennis (occupational therapist). Computers are provided with the software installed. The session is completely 'hands on'. You will have practical experience creating basic home modification recommendations.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completing this course, participants will:

- Have explored the benefits and barriers of using digital images for home modifications
- Be able to add text and annotations to digital images
- Be able to create electronic home modification recommendations
- Know what logistical issues need to be considered when sharing diagrams electronically
